SLOW-NO-WAKE ORDERS FOR LAKE MONONA AND EXTENDED TENNEY LOCK HOURS FOR RHYTHM & BOOMS

Lake Monona: June 28, 2014

As a safety precaution, a Slow-no-wake Order will be enforced Saturday, June 28, 2014 from noon to midnight on Lake Monona for the Rhythm and Booms Event. Boaters are asked to operate at the minimum speed at which a motorized watercraft is able to move and maintain adequate steerage control. In addition, please be aware that there will be a large "No Entry" area strictly enforced surrounding the staging site for Rhythm and Booms at the west end of Lake Monona. The area will be marked with warning buoys. Boaters are encouraged to monitor weather conditions and familiarize themselves with direct access points to shelter along the lake shore.

Dane County Parks Tenney Lock: June 28 and July 3-6, 2014

Tenney Lock hours will be extended (see below for schedule) for Rhythm and Booms on Saturday June 28th and for the 4th of July Holiday weekend from July 3rd through July 6th. The Tenney Lock allows access between Lake Mendota and Lake Monona on the Yahara River.

Clearance height to travel through the Tenney Lock is currently at ~6-feet, however, there may be bridges between Lake Mendota and Lake Mendota where the clearance height may be less than 6-feet. The height will depend on current water elevation.

Extended Tenney Lock Hour Schedule:

Rhythm & Booms 9 AM until midnight or until the last boat in line is through the lock.
